This letter is to confirm that the Florida Department of Transportation has been able to identify \$20 million of additional infrastructure funding to support the Commercial Aircraft (MRO) Campus Expansion project (FPN: 441494-2-94-01). The funding is currently in the process of being removed from several other projects; an amendment process which is expected to take approximately eight weeks. Once these amendments are approved, the funding will then be added to the Commercial Aircraft (MRO) Campus Expansion in Fiscal Year 2021.

The Department's Work Program and budget is adopted annually by the Florida Legislature during the Legislative Session, which occurs during March and April, and is subject to legislative approval.
